HUNTING AREA N. 1 HUNTING N. 1

This amazing hunting area of approximately 27 thousand hectares is located in the north-eastern part of Croatia. The history of this area has been very turbulent, but one thing has remained constant: it has always been known for the abundance of game and hunting opportunities that have made it world famous. The hunting reserve was established in 1679, when Eugene of Savoy received the lands from Emperor Leopold I, and throughout its history it has been owned by various rulers. The hunting area consists of alluvial forests along the Drava and Danube rivers, particularly rich in red deer and wild boar. In this wonderful combination of nature and game, many hunters have taken valuable red stag trophies (up to record 16kg), while driven hunts offer the opportunity to cull up to a hundred wild boars. Hunters can stay in first-class guest houses, which also offer a rich gastronomic offer, especially game dishes.





















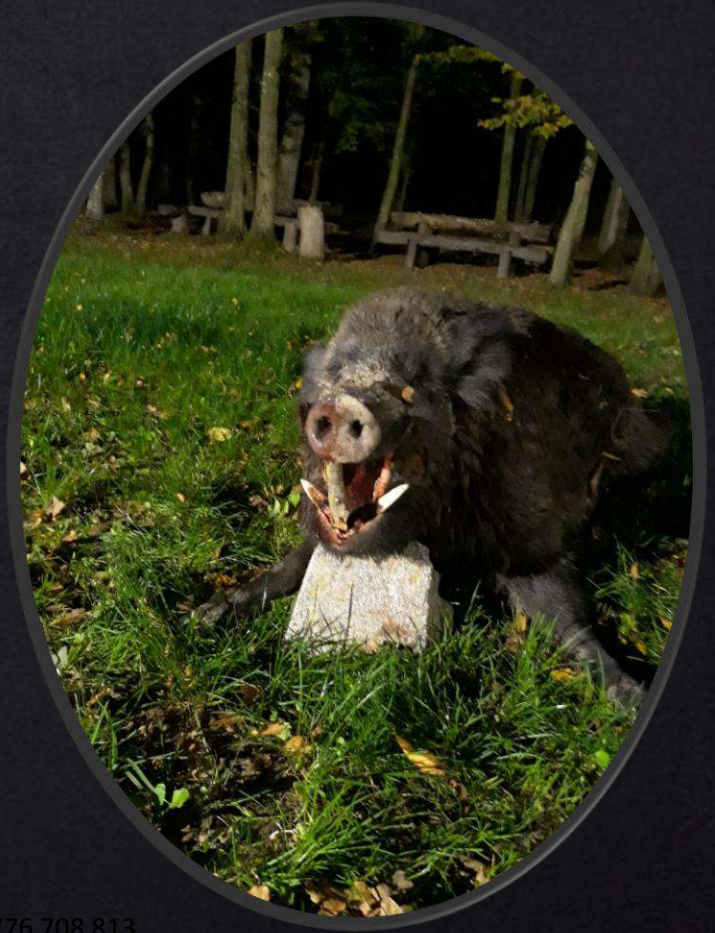






HUNTING AREA N. 2

This hunting ground is located south of the Drava River around 90 km east of Zagreb and covers an area of 7,354 hectares. Lowland oak forests are the habitat of red deer, roe deer and wild boar. The amazing hunting grounds rich in game and the professionally trained staff provide each hunter with an unforgettable hunting experience. Accommodation is available for hunters in a comfortable hunting lodge, with its beautiful surroundings and traditionally friendly staff















HUNTING AREA N. 3

This hunting area of more than 25 thousand hectares is located in the north-eastern part of Croatia, more precisely in south-eastern Slavonia, between the Sava and Danube rivers. The vast Slavonian plains (at an altitude of about 80 metres above sea level), numerous bodies of water and an immense, uninterrupted complex of oak forests form the backdrop for the hunting days. This enchanting natural environment provides an ideal habitat for red deer, roe deer and wild boar. The meadows and wetlands are home to a wide variety of birds and other animals. The hunting area includes a primeval forest and a nature reserve, which remind us of how forests used to be in this part of Europe. Red stag hunts during the rut season and wild boar driven hunts during winter guarantee an unforgettable hunting experience. The comfortable hunting lodge allows hunters to enjoy famous Slavonian specialities after a hard day's hunting.







HUNTING AREA N. 1
HUNTING AREA N. 4

This beautiful hunting area of over 8 thousand hectares is located in the in the eastern part of the Republic of Croatia. In the second half of the 19th century, the bishop's palace expanded and improved an existing hunting area, making it one of the best areas in the country for hunting wild boar and red deer. Even today, hunting is organised in a professional manner, with full respect for Croatian hunting culture and tradition. Wild boar, red deer and roe deer can be hunted. Driven hunts for wild boar are characterised by the large number of boars hunted each day. A good number of medal (strong gold medal as well) trophy red stags deer are hunted each year. Many roe bucks with medal trophies are hunted every year. The hunting lodge is situated in the hunting area and its high standard of services ensures that each guest has a pleasant stay, also thanks to a rich gastronomic offer, including game dishes and renowned local wines.

HUNTING AREA N. 5

This hunting ground sizing around 6000 hectares is located south of the Drava River in the northern/eastern part of Croatia. The lowland oak forests are the habitat of red deer, roe deer and wild boar. This area rich with game and its professional hunting staff will provide each hunter with an unforgettable hunting experience. Accommodation for hunters is provided at a nice hunting lodge where you can taste Slavonian specialities.







HUNTING N. 6

This hunting ground covers an area of 14,931 hectares. It is located about 100 km east of Zagreb. It is a hunting area that will leave every hunter with lasting memories of wild boar hunting and red stag/roe bucks hunting. The excellent offer is characterised by professional hunting organisation, hunting ethics, abundance of game and an environment consisting of combined beech, oak and hornbeam forests. Hunters are welcome to stay at the local hunting lodge, where they will find comfortable accommodation and good food.

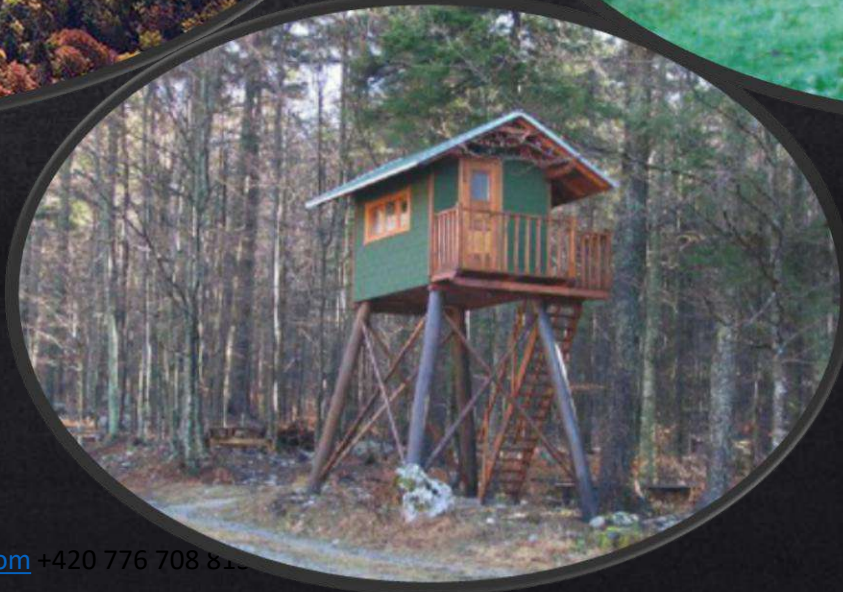






HUNTING AREA N. 7

The hunting ground sizing around 6000 hectares is situated in a low mountains area. It offers an unforgettable experience of wild boar, red deer and roe deer hunting. A patient and persistent hunter can have a chance to shoot a golden trophy roebuck. Hunters are welcome to stay at the local hut.









HUNTING AREA N. 8

On soft slopes around 100 km east of Zagreb, there is a well-managed hunting area sizing around 11 thousand hectares mostly covered by amazing woods rich in game (wild boar, red deer and roe deer). The area is famous for its top-class wild boars driven hunts and red stags hunting during rut season. Excellent service from local professional staff, hunting ethics, abundant game and top quality trophies are the hallmarks of hunting in this area. Accommodation for hunters is available in hunting lodge, with comfortable rooms and a very good gastronomic offer.



HUNTING AREA-FREE N. 9

The 7,000 hectare hunting area is situated in a gentle river valley between rolling hills. It is surrounded by a wide belt of meadows and pastures, and its southern side, between two rivers, is covered with oak and hornbeam forests. Hunting there is a unique experience due to the beauty of the area, the abundance of game and the exceptional trophies of roe bucks, red stags and wild boar.



HUNTING AREA N. 10

Situated some 130km north-east of Zagreb, the 6,000-hectare hunting area is criss-crossed by several streams and surrounded by beautiful nature reserves. Floodplain forests and meadows offer hunters the opportunity to hunt red stags, wild boars and roe bucks with very valuable trophies. In winter, ducks and wild geese can be hunted on the river that runs through the area. Hunters can stay in a comfortable hunting lodge, and fishing is available nearby. If you enjoy the excitement of floodplain hunting, this is the place for you.







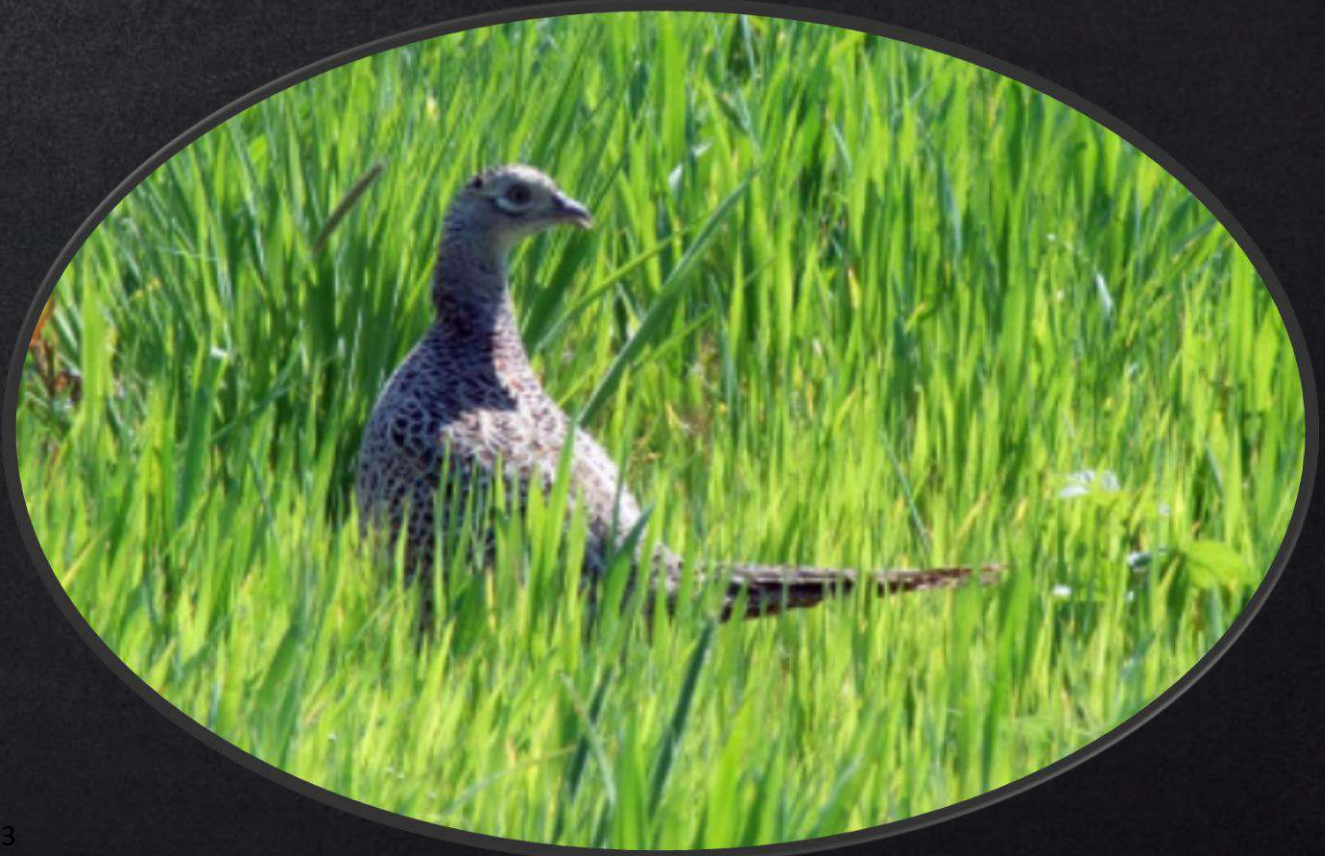






HUNTING AREA N. 11

The hunting area of over 14,000 hectares is about 110 km away and is covered with dense lowland forests, fertile ploughed land and meadows. Part of the area is almost devoid of vegetation due to the wind and forms the so-called Croatian desert. This hunting area is famous for its beautiful landscapes and abundance of game (deer, roe deer, wild boar, hares, pheasants, quails, ducks and geese). One of the largest pheasant breeding in the country is located there and hunts are organised with experienced pointing dogs.



HUNTING AREA N. 12

Between the Sava and Una rivers there is a large forest complex of oak and ash trees. The total area is more than 12 thousand hectares of beautiful humid forest around 120 km south-east of Zagreb. Hunting wild boar and red deer in the autumn mist is a unique experience. Part of the area is reserved for hunting hares, wild ducks, snipe and quail. Comfortable accommodation in hunting lodge.



HUNTING AREA-FREE RANGE N. 13

This hilly hunting area of over 14,000 hectares is situated about 80 km north-west of Zagreb and is famous for its wild boar hunting with many gold medal trophies in the last years. This area boasts an excellent roe deer population as well with medal trophy bucks hunted during each hunting season. Wild duck and snipe, the queen of the forest, can also be hunted on the fringes of the reserve. Hunters can find comfortable accommodation in a recently opened hunting lodge, where they can enjoy game specialities accompanied by local wines.





HUNTING AREA N. 14

This beautiful lowland hunting area sizing around 8000 hectares is located in a valley crossed by a river and is an ideal habitat for wild boar, roe deer and wild ducks, as well as woodcock in the autumn. The well-equipped tree stands allow hunters to hunt wild boar and game birds all year round, as well as roe deer in summer. Accommodation is available in a nice holiday farm or Hotel located in area well known for its good wines and varied gastronomic offer.

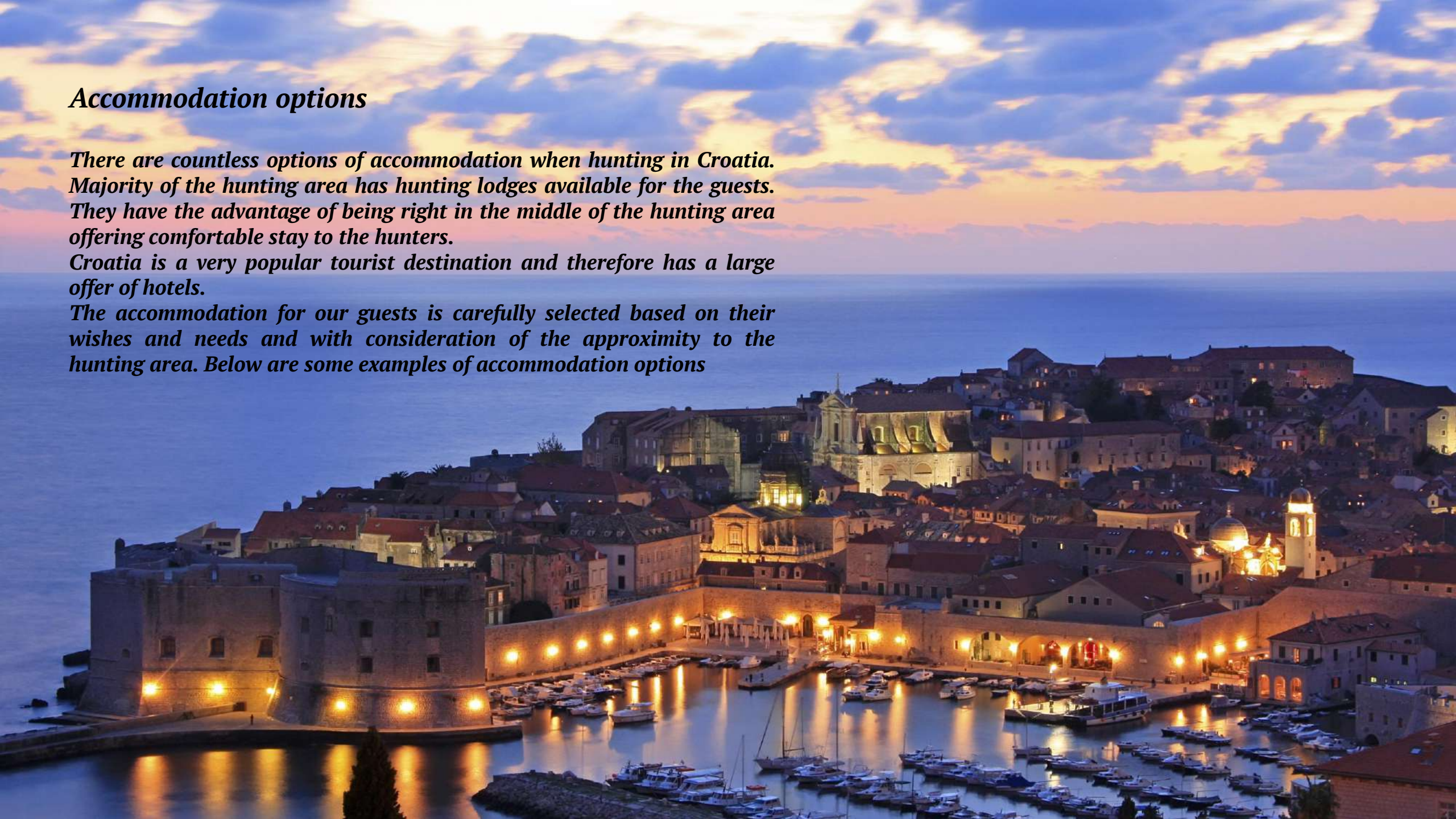


Accommodation options

Accommodation – Hunting Lodge n. 1

Modern hunting lodge built with respects to the surrounding nature, offers very comfortable stay with excellent service. Each of its six rooms is furnished with different type of wood, has sat TV, minibar and internet connection.

The restaurant offers places for events and a beautiful terrace while serving excellent local dishes accompanied by fine wines from the area.

VISIT CROATIA

Summarize the main tourist attractions of this, geographically speaking, small country is really a challenge. Croatia offers incredible natural beauties and architectonical gems divided by the mainland and many islands (there are 79 islands with the surface over 1 km² and over 500 smaller ones). One of the top sightseeing areas is the Krka natural park around the famous seven waterfalls. A part of these you will find there a well-preserved Franciscan monastery from the 15th century on a small island called Visovac. The best know national park in Croatia is without doubts the area of Plitvice lakes, listed on the Unesco list of world heritage. Especially in the spring this is a must to see.

Croatia boasts really a top location on the Adriatic sea side and has over 6000 km of the sea-side. The sea area is well-known for its variety and clean and incredibly transparent sea water. Together with the beautiful sea-side you admire the historical towns alongside such as Split. This second biggest town in Croatia has a history dating back to the second century before Christ when there was a Greek colony. The town itself was founded by Diocletianus, the Roman emperor, at the end of the 3rd century a.C. You will find a proof of this historical act visiting his palace with some well-preserved parts. More on south a must is the town of Dubrovnik with its historical center with tiny medieval streets.

Below a few attractions easily reachable from the hunting areas described in this offer.

ZAGREB

Zagreb has been the political, economic and cultural capital of Croatia since 1991. It is a city off the beaten track of mass tourism, concentrated mainly on the coast, but of disarming beauty. Its charms combine the best of Western and Eastern Europe. There is so much to do in Zagreb. The city is full of museums, galleries, theatres and palaces with Austro-Hungarian, Baroque and Art Nouveau architecture, as well as elegant restaurants, boutiques, shopping centres, pubs and trendy cafes. It is not a city you will fall in love with at first sight, but it will slowly steal your soul. The Upper Town, Gornji grad, is home to the two oldest parts of the city, Kaptol and Gradec; below, 19th and 20th century palaces make up the Lower Town, Donji grad, a lively area with prestigious public buildings and 19th century palaces. Only three hours from the coast, Zagreb is an ideal starting point for exploring Croatia and its many lakes, such as the Jarun reservoirs to the south-west of the city, or its promontories, such as Mount Medvednica in the northern suburbs, which are easy to reach for a day out.



OSIJEK

Osijek is a city with an elegant yet relaxed atmosphere, situated on the southern bank of the Drava River, about 20km from its confluence with the Danube. The historic centre is full of beautiful parks and elegant Viennese-style buildings. These have been restored to their former glory after the destruction caused by bombing during the 1991 war. The food is one of the major draws of the region, so don't leave without trying one of the typical meals. Try riblji paprikas. This is a stew of freshwater fish flavoured (and made hot!) with a variety of local paprikas.



KOPAČKI RIT NATURE RESERVE

The main attraction around Osijek is the Kopački Rit Nature Reserve, a marshy area created by the confluence of the Drava and Danube rivers, surrounded by extremely diverse vegetation. The surrounding marshy lakes, forests and meadows provide shelter for hundreds of animal species, including birds, fish, deer, wild boar, foxes... and lots of mosquitoes! The park can be explored on foot or by car, but the most atmospheric way is certainly a guided boat trip. You can sample the delicious dishes of Slavonia's rich gastronomic tradition in the small restaurants in the area.

Croatian gastronomy

The Croatian cuisine is specific for every region, reflecting the country's geography, history, and culture. The northern and southern areas of the Adriatic are characterized by the so called Mediterranean diet, that is considered to be one of the healthiest. Cheeses from Pag or Lika, "mišni sir" (cheese matured in a sheepskin bag) or Dalmatian and Istrian prosciutto are definitely to taste. Along the Adriatic coast you will feel the tradition of grilling and roasting fish and delicacies of the sea that has been carried down by generations. In the north of Croatia on the other hand the Austro-Hungarian culinary influences are more evident.

Together with the local dishes you will have to try their wine, the sunny climate of Croatia makes it very special. The kumbasice sausages from Skradin or Drnic prosciutto are to be eaten with a glass of Babic red wine from Primošten.

Croatian game dishes

In Croatia you still find restaurants where you can taste venison in black soup, a delicacy from the superb cookery book of Count Nikola Zrinski. In addition to providing descriptions of numerous specialties of the time, this guide through fine cuisine is particularly inspired by dishes prepared with game. The nobility of the time enjoyed roast wild duck, medallions of venison, or game prosciutto. Many of the delicacies have been preserved through the years. On special festive occasions, the local folk will serve one of the most delectable dishes from the Count's cookery book: wild boar roasted in honey.
