



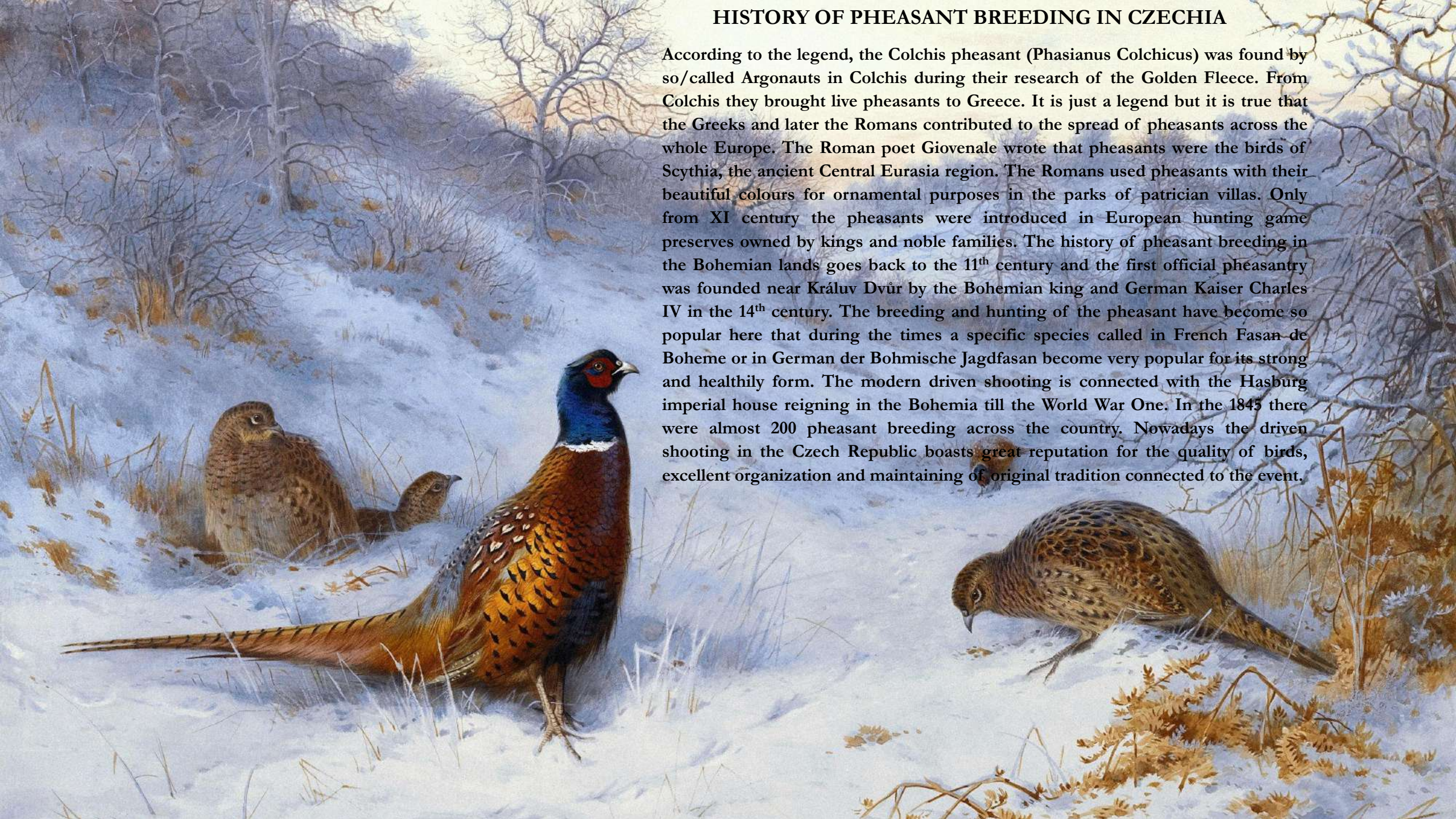

HISTORY OF PHEASANT BREEDING IN CZECHIA

According to the legend, the Colchis pheasant (*Phasianus Colchicus*) was found by so-called Argonauts in Colchis during their research of the Golden Fleece. From Colchis they brought live pheasants to Greece. It is just a legend but it is true that the Greeks and later the Romans contributed to the spread of pheasants across the whole Europe. The Roman poet Giovenale wrote that pheasants were the birds of Scythia, the ancient Central Eurasia region. The Romans used pheasants with their beautiful colours for ornamental purposes in the parks of patrician villas. Only from XI century the pheasants were introduced in European hunting game preserves owned by kings and noble families. The history of pheasant breeding in the Bohemian lands goes back to the 11th century and the first official pheasantry was founded near Králuv Dvůr by the Bohemian king and German Kaiser Charles IV in the 14th century. The breeding and hunting of the pheasant have become so popular here that during the times a specific species called in French Fasan de Boheme or in German der Bohmische Jagdfasan become very popular for its strong and healthy form. The modern driven shooting is connected with the Hasburg imperial house reigning in the Bohemia till the World War One. In the 1845 there were almost 200 pheasant breeding across the country. Nowadays the driven shooting in the Czech Republic boasts great reputation for the quality of birds, excellent organization and maintaining of original tradition connected to the event.

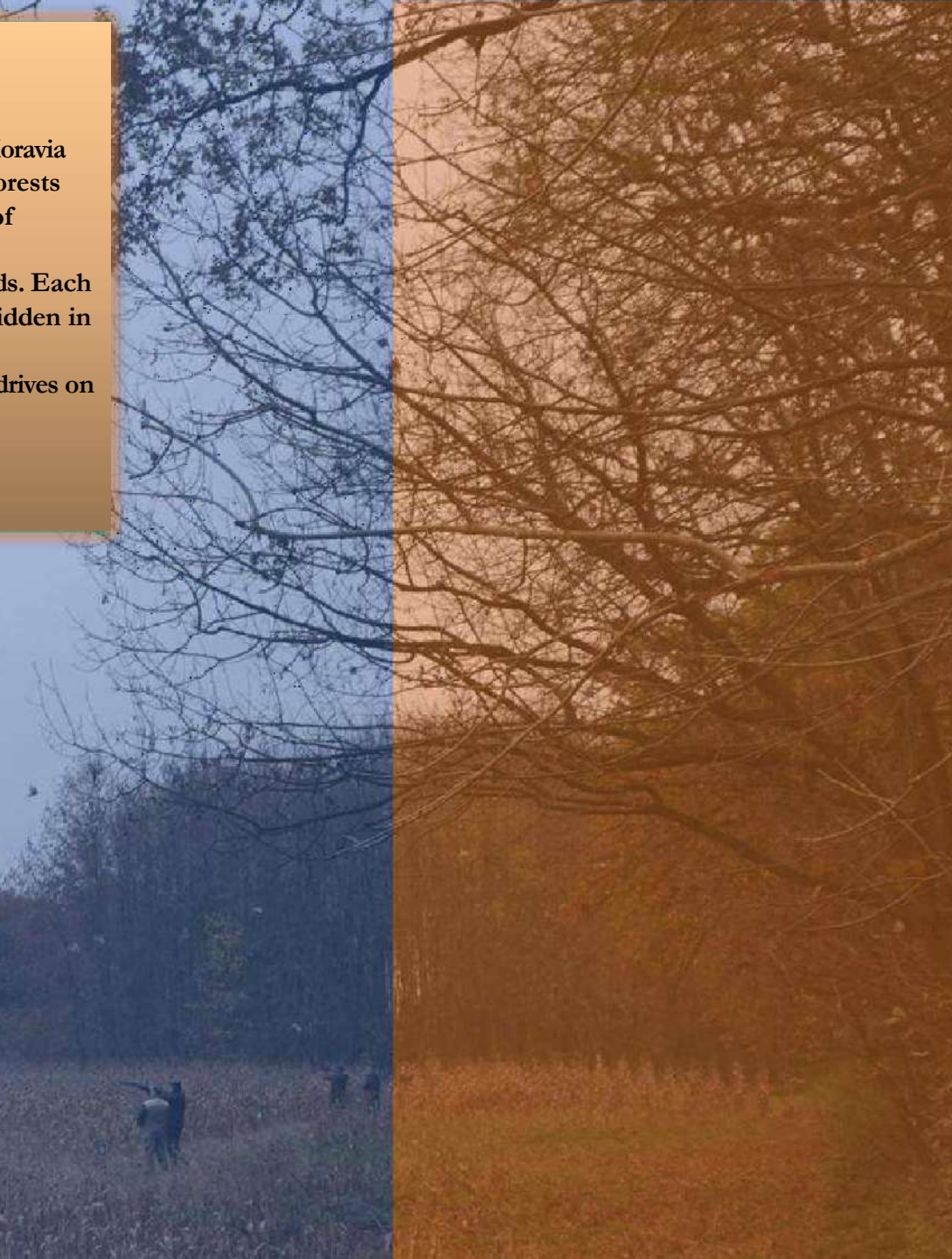
Shooting area

One of the smaller pheasantries in our offer covers an area of 500 hectares. Beautiful landscape of southern Moravia offers shooting in mainly flat terrain covered by forest. This is a forest environment dominated by deciduous forests (mainly oaks and ash). The forests are mature and alternate between low stands, thickets and linear plantings of shrubs.

The pheasant leches themselves are divided by small fields of corn which are interspersed between these woods. Each field is on the edge of a good cover of shrubs which form the bulk of the pheasantry. The pheasants are hidden in these and flit between the fields and the woods.

A system of woodland paths divides the pheasantry into several units. This makes it possible to reach all the drives on foot, which are so easily accessible.

Local experienced staff has been organizing the shoot here for more than 30 years according to the Czech hunting traditions and ceremonies.





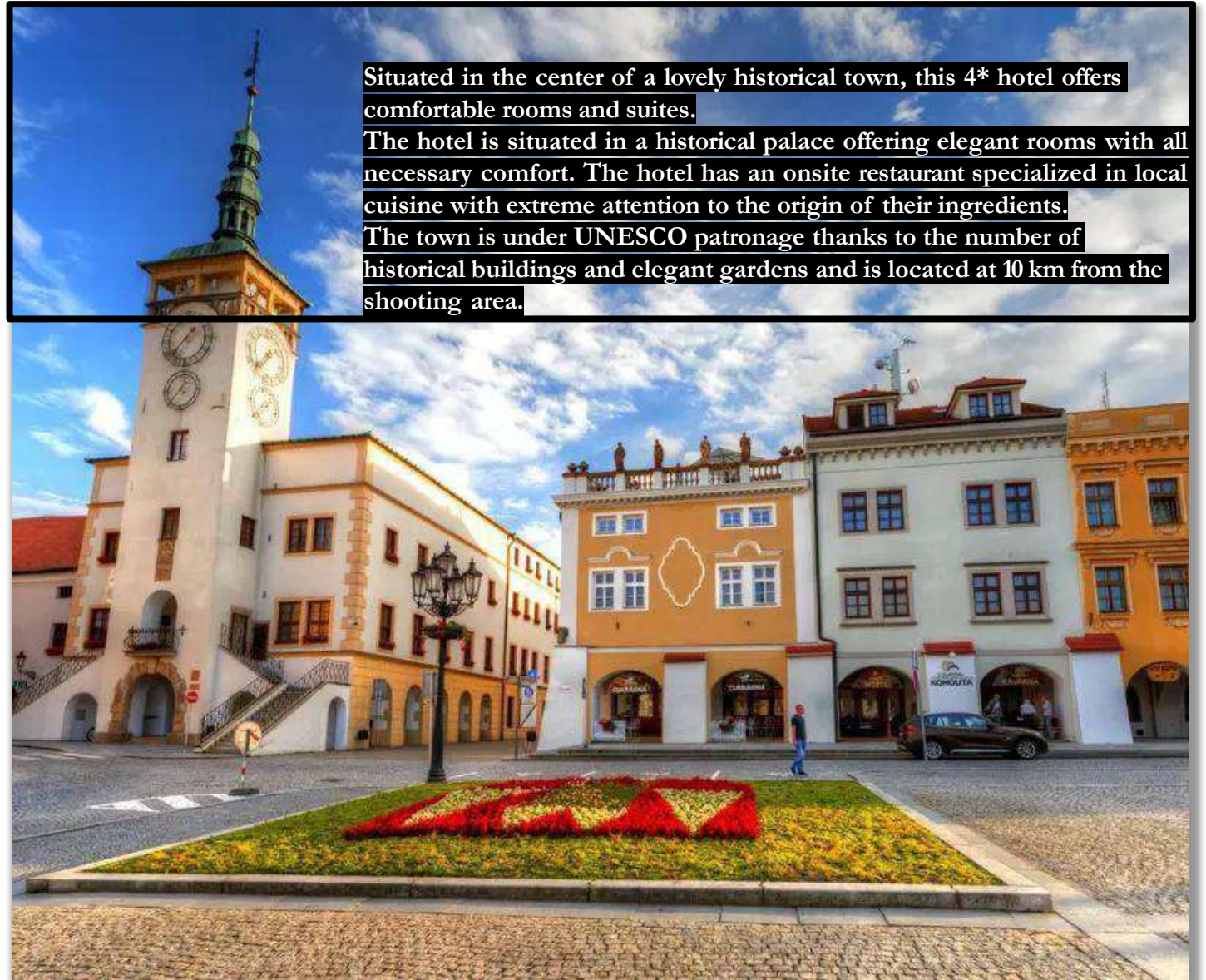












Situated in the center of a lovely historical town, this 4* hotel offers comfortable rooms and suites.

Shooting area

This hunting ground is located in a beautiful area just a short drive from the town of České Budějovice in South Bohemia. This part of the Czech Republic is known for its natural beauty with lakes, dense forests and historical sites such as the neo-Gothic castle on the shooting location. The hunting area covers an area of 1250 ha, and the drives are grouped together over an area of more than 600 ha. The drives are of varying degrees of difficulty and offer excitement for all types of gun.

The terrain is covered by fields, meadows, forests and small lakes.











Accommodation

Pleasant stay is assured in a charming 4* hotel at very easy distance to the shooting area, approx. 10 min drive. The hotel is located in a small historical town dominated by beautiful chateau on the hill above the hotel. The hotel offers comfort stay and sleep in elegant Superior rooms and Apartments. The standards of flat TV, free wi-fi and English speaking staff of the hotel, go without saying.

Offer n. 3

First - class shooting area

Driven pheasant shooting days of this offer occur in area sizing around 1000 hectares in the northern part of the Czech Republic. History of these grounds goes back to 19th century when a local noble family conceived an area for pheasant shooting in British style. The terrain has a hilly, sloping profile and is largely covered by forests with tall trees. The degree of difficulty of the various day drives ranges from medium-high to very high, making this area very suitable for mixed groups with experienced guns. Some of the drives are extremely challenging, with guns placed in depressions in the terrain, with pheasants flying very high in narrow corridors between the trees. Other drives give the guns chances to shoot birds flying high from a distance. The pheasants are released in the area months before the season and are of excellent quality with lustrous plumage and long tails. The local staff has many years of experience in organising flawless driven pheasants shoots. Each shooting day begins with a refreshment with hot drinks and a check of the necessary documents. Two-three drives are scheduled in the morning, followed by a hunter's snack (soup, sausages and apple pie). In the afternoon another 2-3 drives are planned.

At the end of the shoot a late lunch is served (while the staff prepares the closing ceremony). The entire organisation is in full accordance with the old hunting traditions of the Czech Republic (hunting musicians, awarding the best shooter, etc.).













Accommodation in small Chateau

Housed in a Renaissance building from the early 16th century, the hotel offers historical rooms with wooden roof beams and underfloor heating. All items of furniture are genuine period pieces, purchased at antique auctions. Some of the rooms have baldachin beds and all of them are equipped with attention to details. They feature free Wi-Fi. There is a non-smoking restaurant. Guests can sample traditional recipes prepared in the modern kitchen or over the open hearth in the centre of the restaurant itself. Home-grown ingredients, fresh herbs and organic products are used. An experienced sommelier will assist in choosing among fine Moravian and international wines from the original wine cellar with a vaulted ceiling.

This accommodation is 30 min drive from the shooting grounds.

TOP CLASS SHOOTING AREA

High quality pheasant driven shooting in Southern Bohemia, around 100 km from Prague Airport. We are talking about amazing area sizing many hundreds of hectares where around 13000 pheasants are shot during each season. Location of pheasant shooting is the wonderful countryside of Southern Bohemia. A flawless organization of shooting days together with lay of land (steep terrain) and quality of pheasants assure the most favourable conditions for driven shooting with very high-flying birds. Pheasants are mainly bred in breeding stations inside shooting area and great emphasis is placed on health, general maturity and adaptability of maturing chicks to the harsh conditions of life in the wild. Pheasants are released at the age of 10-12 weeks and they must adapt to life in open forest.









Accommodation

Comfortable castle hotel with 30 min drive to the shooting area. It is located in a historical estate dating back to the 14th century, that was carefully refurbished after 1989.

The hotel offers very comfortable room together with modern restaurant serving carefully prepared meals from local products. The hotel has also a wine cellar with large offer of bottles from all over the world, and a modern Spa area.

FIRST CLASS AREAS WITH VERY HIGH FLYING PHEASANTS

Driven pheasant shoots take place in an area of over 2000 hectares where 50,000 pheasants are released each year. Local breeding stations produce healthy young birds with a good ability to adapt to the harsh conditions of life in the wild. Pheasants are usually released at 10 weeks of age. A high percentage of released birds are lost. This means that during the shooting days you will find well developed birds with beautiful plumage and long tails. The area is largely wooded with tall trees. All drives on the two day shoot are of good to excellent quality. Some of the drives are extremely challenging as the guns are placed in narrow gorges between rocks and surrounded by tall trees with the pheasants flying very high over their heads. Other drives are organised in such a way that guns see pheasants arriving from a distance, flying very high over hills and tall trees. As many of our guests from UK and other countries can attest, there is no doubt that this area can satisfy even the most demanding guns.

A very pleasant stay is assured in a Classicistic Chateau set around 70 km from Prague and near the shooting area. Surrounded by a beautiful English park famous for its sequoia trees that are under over 160 years old. The Chateau has been carefully refurbished in past years using modern material while maintaining its historical charm. Elegant rooms offer comfortable sleep, fast free internet connection, cable TV and minibars, while the suites also have large living rooms. The Chateau offers a luxurious wellness area and multiuse sport camp. The hotel's Restaurant serves a selection of Czech and international cuisine accompanied by fine local and foreign wines.

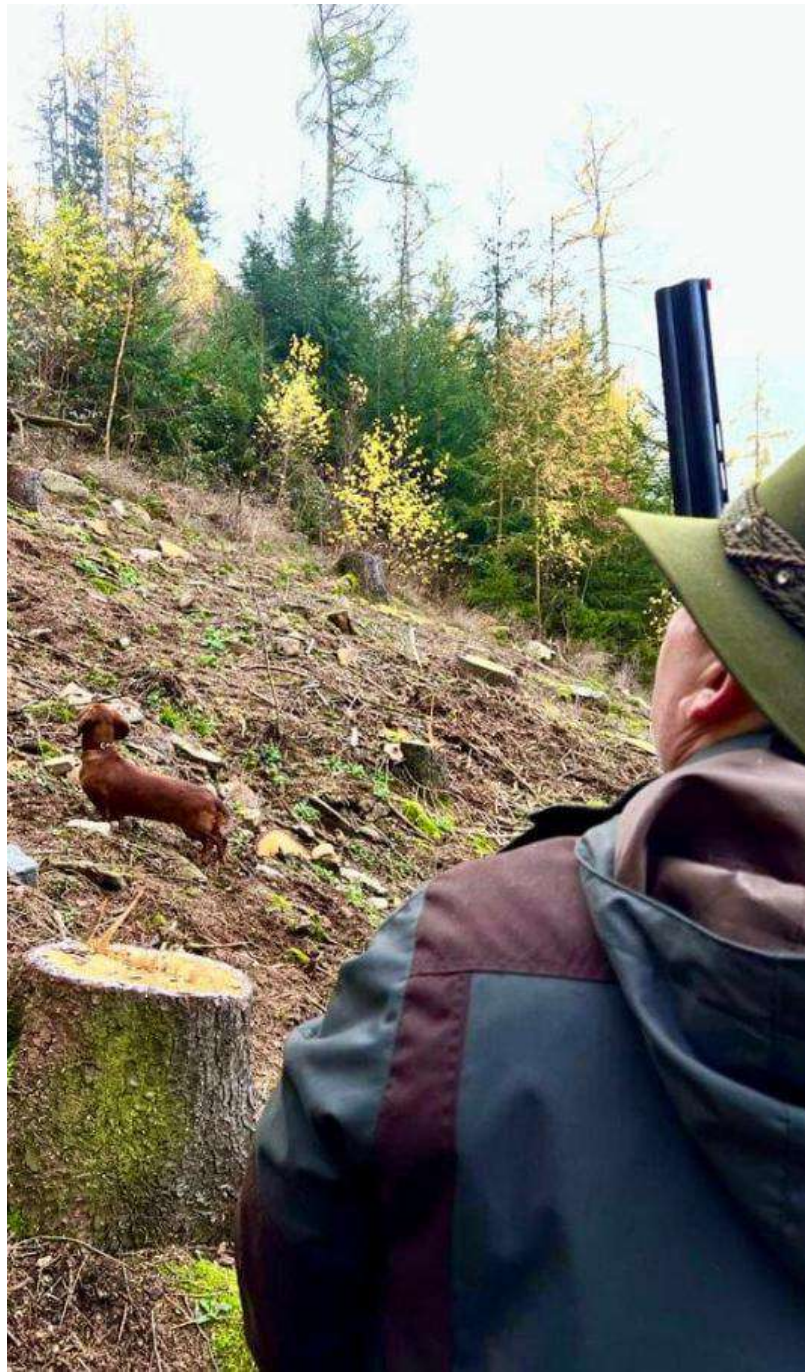

TOP NOTCH AREA WITH HIGH FLYING PHEASANTS

Pheasant hunting takes place on a carefully managed 1,100-hectare hunting estate. Years ago, part of the estate was dedicated to pheasant hunting on steep terrain, with areas covered by tall trees and others by cornfields and meadows. The terrain, high standard organisation and quality of the pheasants ensure an exciting experience for even the most demanding guns, who only want to see pheasants that fly high. Driven pheasant shoots are organised for groups of five to fifteen guns in such a way to ensure an excellent experience for everyone. The daily bag can range from 300 to 2,000 pheasants. The shoots are organised in accordance with ancient traditions, including displaying the shot pheasants and sounding hunting horns.
