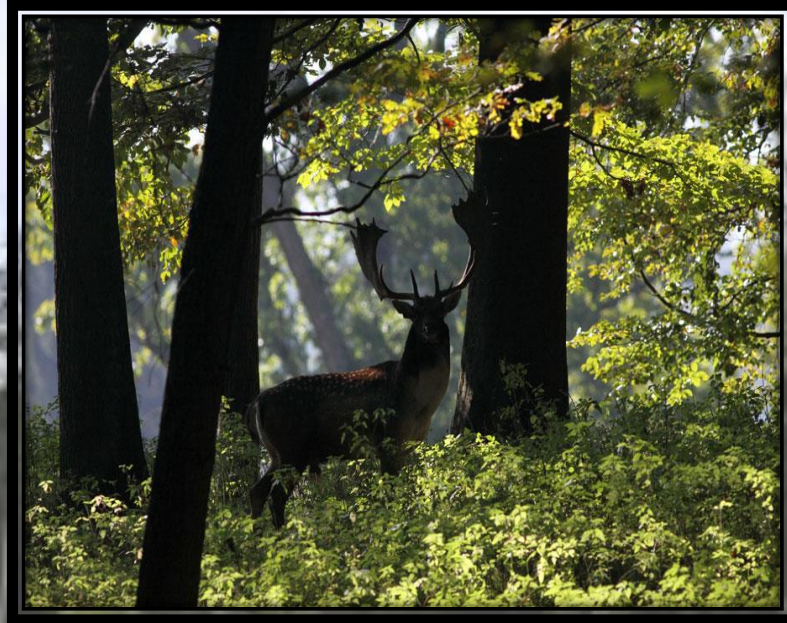

Hunting days occur in 3 historic game reserves built for hunting purposes from 15th to 18th century. The 5-star hotel is located in a former Jesuit dormitory from the 16th century in the unique historic centre of the town of Český Krumlov, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The oldest hunting museum in Europe, many other tourist attractions, fancy restaurants and an appropriate language support contribute to make your stay special.

GAME RESERVE N. 1

The first hunting area, sizing 1500 hectares (3700 acre), is covered by coniferous and broadleaf forests, old oak tree avenues, small fields and lakes. It is situated at 380-575 meters above sea level. The first notes about this game reserve date back to the 15th century, which make this reserve one of the oldest one in the Czech history. The main games are fallow deer, mouflons and wild boars. The game boasts beautiful medal trophies. The fallow deer trophies are up to 230 CIC points, mouflon trophies up to 245 CIC points and wild boar trophies up to 130 CIC points.

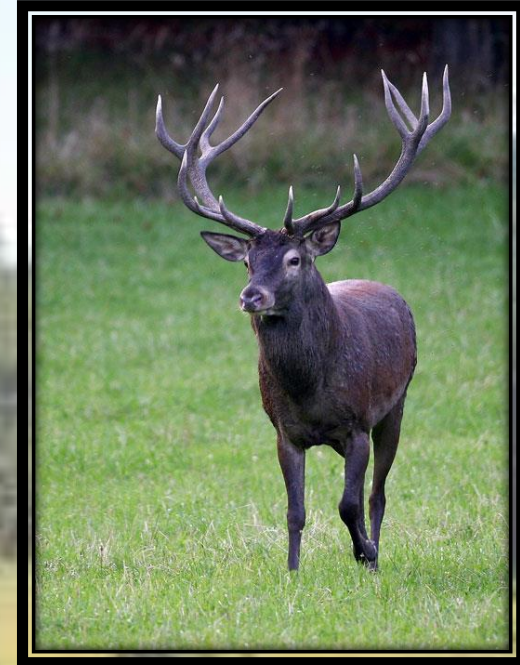

GAME RESERVE N. 2

The second game reserve, sizing 1650 hectares (4077 acre), is located in hilly country. Its relief is characterized by deep stream valleys and flat areas covered with meadows and fishponds. The first notes about this game reserve date back to the 17th century. The game reserve is part of the NATURA 2000 protected areas. The dominant tree species are broadleaved trees (52 %), followed by conifers (48 %). Ancient oak trees grow along roads. The game reserve is elevated 450-550 meters above sea level. Main games are red deer (trophies up to 262 CIC Points) and wild boars with trophies up to 125 CIC Points.

GAME RESERVE N. 3

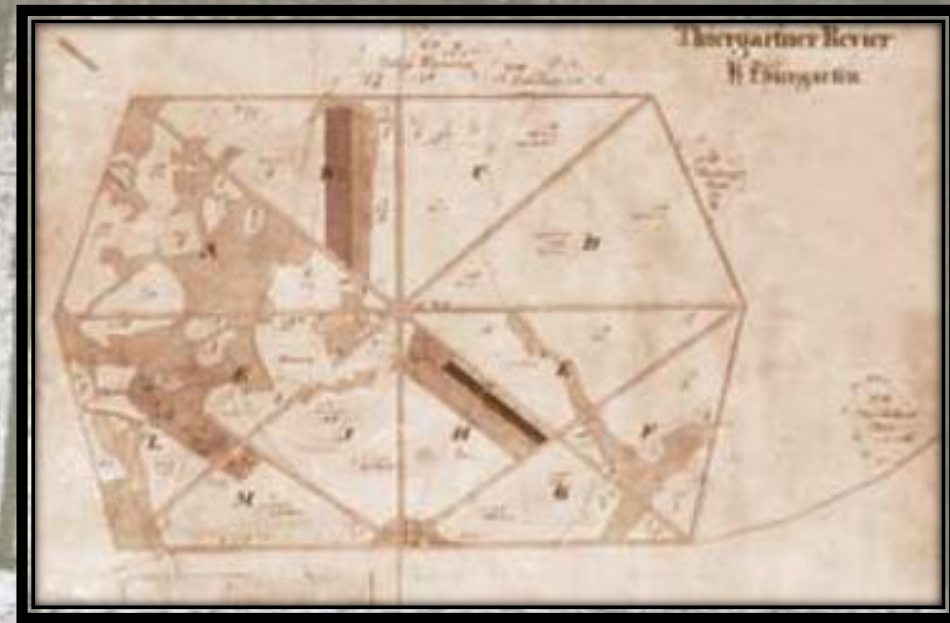
The origins of this game reserve date back to XVIII century. The area has an hexagonal form sizing around 300 hectares. Altitude varies from 450 to 500 meters above sea level. Grounds are mainly covered with conifers, broad-leaved trees and ponds. There are many centuries-old oaks and chestnuts. This area boasts an excellent population of wild boars, sika dybowski deer and fallow deer. Wild boar and sika sybowski trophies are mainly gold and silver medal. The wild boar record trophy reached 135 CIC Points. The fallow buck record trophy reached 210 CIC Points. Very experienced hunting staff manages individual hunts providing high standard services.

HUNTING PERIOD

The whole period from August to February is advisable for gripping hunts in the 3 above described game reserves. Based on selected area and games that guests wish to hunt we can suggest more precise periods. As an example we strongly recommend September (rutting season) if you want to hunt strong red stags in game reserve n. 1.

HUNTING METHOD

The hunting days are usually organised in the form of stalking or lying in wait on towers-high seats placed in strategic positions. Two hunting outputs are scheduled each day, the first in the early morning starting before dawn, the second one in the late afternoon-evening during the hours around sunset.

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS NEARBY

ORLÍK CHATEAU

It used to be a Gothic castle rising on the rock above the river. The dam built in the 20th century moved the castle above its surface. Today, the Orlík Reservoir is hiding a church of the former village and if the water surface goes down, you can even see some of the foundations of the flooded houses. The Orlík Chateau was built in the 13th century and was a mansion of the Czech noble family. You can tour its romantic richly decorated interior or take a walk in its park. There is also an aquarium near the Chateau parking lot where you can see a fish exposition or exposition of construction of the Orlík Reservoir and you can read some stories about families from the flooded village.

The historic city center is a on the UNESCO list and if you pass through the Český Krumlov medieval picturesque streets, you will understand why. THE HUNTING MUSEUM

The museum focuses on the history of hunting and falconry tradition as a unique phenomenon listed by UNESCO. It boasts a collection of trophies and a collection of historical cold weapons and firearms. The first collection of hunting trophies, stuffed games and birds were exhibited and made accessible to the public in 1842. Nowadays the museum features over 400 trophies, including antlers of the extinct Schomburg deer.

TRADITIONAL RESTAURANT RECOMMENDED BY US

Traditional Czech restaurant recommended by St. Hubertus Hunting Tours is situated in an historic building just a few meters from the main square of Český Krumlov. The history of the building dates back to the 14th century. Painter Josef Palouda from Český Krumlov, who has been studying for many years in Italy the classical techniques "Trompe l'Oeil", is the author of mural paintings in the interior. Menu is mainly based on Czech specialities, dishes from the fresh freshwater fish and saltwater fish at first. Quality fresh ingredients are the main feature of this restaurant. Raw materials are bought from local producers, growers and farms. Wines, combined with meals, have been carefully selected to the list of wines (Moravian wines and wines from the most famous European wine districts). FISHING FARMING AND THE TŘEBON CARP

With its 460 fishponds, the Třebon district is the largest centre of fish farming in the Czech Republic. The tradition of fish farming dates back to the 14th century, when the first fishponds were founded here. Třebon's fish farming tradition experienced its golden age during the 16th century, when the Třebon domain was ruled by the powerful Rožmberk family. Today, Třebon fish farming boasts the fine-quality Třebon carp, the popularity of which extends beyond the boundaries of the Czech Republic. The meat of the Třebon Carp is distinguished by high quality, a light, buttery taste and low fat content. The unique taste is the result of long-term breeding in high-quality water and the specific natural environment of the Třebon Basin. The original fried carp recipe, still used to this day, has been attributed to Magdalena Dobromila Rettigová (1785-1845), who is considered by many to be the mother of Czech cuisine after having compiled recipes which now characterize the food Czechs call their own.

FRIED CARP AND POTATO SALAD CZECH RECIPE

Fried Carp Recipe

Breaded Fried Carp (one serving)

300g carp (uncleaned)

10g salt

20g flour

¼ egg

0.05 liter milk

40g breadcrumbs

100g vegetable oil

Debone, remove skin and clean fish, pat dry. Dip cleaned fish filets in salt/flour mixture, then egg/milk mixture, and finally breadcrumbs. Fry slowly in hot oil until golden brown.

Potato Salad (one serving)

200g potatoes (peeled and diced)

20g carrots (peeled and diced)

20g celery (cleaned and diced)

20g parsley root (peeled and diced)

20g gherkins (diced)

10g onion (peeled, blanched, and diced)

1g salt

2g vinegar

2g sugar

1g pepper

20g mayonnaise

20g natural yogurt

10g lemon juice

Boil potatoes, carrot, celery and parsley root until tender. Drain liquid, add gherkins and onions. Add the rest of the ingredients and mix well. When complete, refrigerate before serving.
